We then continue the meeting with a bible based talk finishing around 12.00noon. Tea, coffee and biscuits are then served for a time of relaxing and chatting.

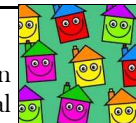
If you have any questions or comments please feel free to speak with one of the people who led the meeting or complete a contact card and leave in the red box at the entrance.

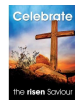
"Towards Housegroup" - Doing Life Together

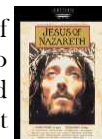


"Explore" Notes
