**If** you have any questions or comments please feel free to speak with one of the people who led the meeting or complete a contact card and leave in the red box at the entrance.

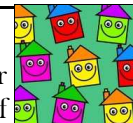

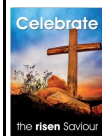
## Housegroups - “Doing Life Together”
