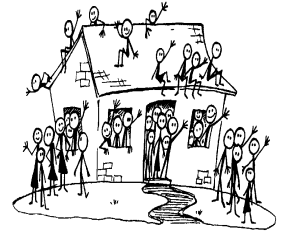

If you have any questions or comments please feel free to speak with one of the people who led the meeting or complete a contact card and leave in the red box at the entrance.

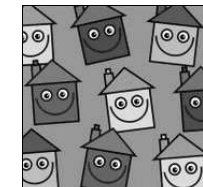
We do not normally take up an offering in our meetings. If you are interested in supporting the church financially there is a box available by the entrance door.
