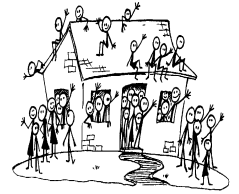

the entrance.

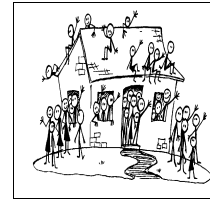
We do not normally take up an offering

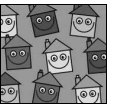


“The Big Issue”
